Notes

Note 1: Interval for 1998-2002 ALH cars may be increased to 100k at belt replacement if updated parts are installed.

Note 2: Updated from initial spec, owner's manual may list incorrect interval of 90k or 100k, later changed to 80k.

Note 3: 2005-06 Jettas with DSG trans require DSG service every 40k, therefore due at 80k along with T-belt.

Note 4: These engines have two timing belts, for cam and injection pump -- replace both every 75k.
